Fees and Discounts: The fee for the seven (7) week session is $\$ 100$.
BRDTC offers the following discounts for classes: $\$ 25$ per class for BRDTC members - OR - $\$ 10$ discount for the first class to any dog adopted from the County Shelter or Humane Society or other recognized 501c3 rescue organization - OR - $\$ 10$ off each dog for multiple dogs from the same family - OR - $\$ 10$ discount for senior citizens ( $60+$ ). ONE discount allowed per family per session.
Parking: Primary parking for BRDTC students is in the lots in the front or to the right of Sportsplex building.
Head-in parking in the rear currently is primarily for instructors and handicapped. BRDTC door is last door in the rear of the building. DO NOT park in adjacent business lots or in spaces reserved for other tenants along the rear of the building. The remaining pavement in the rear of the building is a fire lane and must be kept clear.

Run-Thrus**: No advance sign-up needed, unless specified on Activities Calendar. Open all who have appropriate level of experience in that particular dog sport. Show up and pay for as many runs as you would like to do. Fees vary.

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## Course Descriptions

## OBEDIENCE CLASSES

Star Puppy Obedience: Puppies ages 3 to 5 months.
Get off to a great start with your puppy. At the conclusion of the class, puppies will have the option to test for AKC STAR Puppy designation.
Beginner I Obedience: Dogs ages 6 months and up.
Learn positive behavior modification, attention, proper leash handling and manners, and fundamental behaviors including recall, sit, stay, wait, down, and stand.

## Beginner II Obedience:

Prerequisite-STAR Puppy or Beginner I \&/or Permission of Training Director. Strengthen basic obedience skills and develop stronger teamwork between handler and dog. Emphasis on beginning Competition Obedience skills.

## Exploration of Dog Sports/Activities I:

Prerequisite - Completion of Beginning Obedience Class. Dog should be age 7 months \& up. Refresh \& expand obedience skills \& work on exercises for Beginner Novice Obedience \& Rally. Focus on self-control \& attention. Students who complete this class may be able to move on to Exploration II or Foundations of Agility, with Instructor Permission.

## Exploration of Dog Sports/Activities II:

Prerequisite- Completion of Exploration I. Dog should be age 9
months or up. Focus on skills essential to dog-sports. Includes introduction to Rally and foundations of agility. Students who complete this class may be able to move on to Fundamentals of Agility I, with Instructor Permission.
Preparation for Performance Obedience:
Prerequisite - Puppy or Basic Obedience. Class addressing ring stress due to fading food lures, lack of focus, and/or environmental factors affecting the dog's performance.

## Competition Obedience:

Prerequisite— Completion of Basic Obedience through Exploration of Dog Sports I or Obedience Title \& Instructor Permission.
For dogs/handler teams interested in working toward their CD or other competition obedience title.

## Open Obedience:

Prerequisite - Preparation for Performance Obedience or Competition Obedience or CD title and Instructor Permission.
This class targets handler skills needed for competing in Open Obedience and for those pursuing a CDX title. Class will include the following: heeling, command discrimination, drop on recall, retrieving exercises, jumping exercises. Dog/Handler teams must have attained at least one leg toward the UKC or AKC Companion Dog title or have instructor permission.

## RALLY CLASSES

Novice Rally: Prerequisite- Exploration I.
Introduction to the sport of Rally. AKC Novice Rally signs and rules will be covered. Dogs should have basic skills in obedience necessary to complete maneuvers and short sequences on lead.
Advanced Rally: Prerequisite- Novice Rally title \&/or Instructor Permission.
Dogs should have earned their RN. Exercises will focus on the AKC Open/Excellent Rally signs and exercises.

## AGILITY CLASSES

## Foundations of Agility I: Prerequisite- Exploration I \&

 Instructor Permission. Dog should be at least age 6 months. Students should have some off-leash control of their dog in order to be eligible for this class. Introduction of self-control and focus exercises, fundamental handling skills, team-building, and groundwork essential to future agility success.Fundamentals of Agility I: Prerequisite-Foundations of Agility \&/or Instructor Permission. Dog should be at least age 10 months. Students must have off-leash control of their dog in order to be eligible for this class. Introduction of lowered equipment, selfcontrol exercises, $2 \times 2$ method of weave pole training, \& fundamental skills \& groundwork essential to future agility success.
Fundamentals of Agility II: Prerequisite- Fundamentals I \& Instructor Permission. Dog should be at least age 12 months.
Continued development of hander skills \& dog skills including reliable contact behaviors and execution of lowered equipment, continued development of $2 \times 2$ weave poles, jumping skills, etc.
Beginning Agility: Prerequisite- Fundamentals II \& Instructor Permission. Dog should be at least age $\mathbf{1 5}$ months. Dogs may be tested at the first class and should have competence on agility equipment at lowered heights. Skills emphasized will include competency progressing toward full-sized equipment, developing handling skills including crosses, drills, and simple sequences. Advanced Beginning Agility: Prerequisite-Beginning Agility \& Instructor Permission. Dogs may be tested at first class. Preparation for competition. Emphasis on handling challenges, sequences, skills, and competency on full-size equipment.
Novice Agility: Prerequisite- Advanced Beginning Agility \& Instructor Permission. Focusing on introductory competition handling at the AKC Novice level of course design. Dogs should be able to do all obstacles at full height.
Open Agility: Prerequisite - Novice Agility Title or Equivalent \& Instructor Permission. Dogs should be competent at six (6) regular weaves and working to master 12 weaves. Class difficulty will be at AKC Open level.

## Advanced Agility: Prerequisite- Open Agility Title or Equivalent

 \& Instructor Permission. For dogs who are actively competing and are ready to move forward from Open Agility. Class difficulty will be at the AKC Excellent/Masters level.Advanced Competition Agility: Prerequisite—Agility Title \& Instructor Permission. Focus on today's challenging Excellent/ Masters \& Premier competition using actual courses from AKC trials.

## OTHER CLASSES

CGC/Therapy Dog Prep: Prerequisite- Exploration I or Instructor Permission. For students pursuing the Canine Good Citizenship certificate and/or test to have a registered therapy dog. Focus on exercises from CGC and several national Therapy Dog tests.
Novice Tricks: Prerequisite- Beginner Obedience or Instructor Permission. Class will focus on Novice level AKC/DMWYD (Do More With Your Dog) Tricks Training and titling. Instructor will offer testing each week for those interested in pursuing titles, as well as offering testing dates following course completion.
